When becoming a member of the Party, every person must write their full name, village/town, and Aadhaar number on the last page of the Party Constitution or in a membership register and affix their signature.

The act of signing shall mean that the person legally accepts all conditions, rules, procedures, and provisions contained in the Party Constitution.

Constitution of the XYZ Political Party

Preamble: Purpose and Objectives

Executive Summary:

The opening sections of the Party Constitution serve as its Preamble and foundational principles. They present the XYZ Political Party not as an ordinary political organization but as a revolutionary, unprecedented experiment in Indian democracy.

The core purpose is to prioritize honest, selfless, character-driven citizen/social-workers, protect ancient Indian cultural values, fulfil the collective aspirations of the nation. Party aims to embed uncompromising honesty, complete transparency, and ironclad accountability into governance. **The Constitution is written with extraordinary self-binding mechanisms — including self-destruct clause if the Party fails to deliver on 80% of its Manifesto within five years of getting majority— making it unlike any other party constitution in the world.** It draws inspiration from great historical figures, critiques the failures of conventional democracy & dynastic politics, and commits to using innovative tools like Grok AI, the Divine Lottery system, and strict term limits at all levels in country.

The Party rejects:- post-election alliances (from third election it faces), compromises with corrupt elements, and power-sharing with those who amassed wealth through looting the nation. It places the ultimate responsibility for real change on the ability of people to vote in a manner so that Party's government if formed, while declaring that Party constitution's pioneering words/concepts will surely deliver the expected. They should reject parties that run on hollow slogans and instead stand firmly behind this Party, which possesses the best and most revolutionary Constitution in the world. The era of kings and monarchies is over. The time has now come to end the system of permanent positions and thrones for leaders, dynastic rule, and the corrupt practice whereby “the dominant caste of every region is given a share in power by all parties.” Otherwise, it is clearly visible that within a few years India risks becoming like Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Nigeria, Somalia, or a declining England.

The Indian public has grown weary of leaders who deliver only speeches. Yet these leaders, exploiting the lack of clear directional guidance from their own party constitutions, have continued to devastate the country through empty rhetoric.

Learning from the bitter experiences of all parties, the Constitution of our Party, along with its transformative modus operandi and policies, explicitly lays down the binding commitments Party workers and leaders must uphold in order to bring about genuine change in the nation. **No constitution of any political party in the world contains such detailed, uncompromising provisions regarding policies, laws, strict timelines, self-dissolution guarantees, and binding accountability at every level of power.**

Our Constitution is the exception. It is not merely a document on paper but a sacred, indivisible covenant between the Party and the people — **crafted not to acquire power, but to ensure that once power is obtained, it never slips away from the hands of the people, and that the Party will hold itself strictly accountable until every word of this Constitution is translated into reality.**

The Objectives of the Party are as follows:

1. To emerge as the Party with the strongest, most revolutionary, and most uncompromisingly people-centric Constitution in the world — earning the identity of **“Party with the Best Constitution...!”** and **“Amazing Leaders’ Party...!”**
2. To make every word of the Preamble of the Indian Constitution a living reality — not merely through speeches, but through concrete laws, policies, and enforceable timelines. To immediately translate into everyday public life the core principles of the Indian Constitution — Justice, Liberty, Equality, and Fraternity — turning them from mere words on paper into lived reality.
3. To maintain unwavering commitment to the principle that, if the people elect the Party’s government at all levels, the governments’ guided by this Party Constitution will permanently resolve or lay a rock-solid foundation for solving every major national problem — from corruption to employment, justice delivery, agriculture, education, environment, and citizen protection/security & social harmony — **within the first six to twelve months.**

4. **If the Party, even after being given power by the people, fails to fulfil 80% of its Manifesto commitments within five years (except for certain complex, chronic problems that need more time), then one hundred spiritually inclined entrepreneurs — each of whom is a taxpayer and has created at least 500 jobs — may file a petition to dissolve the Party.**
- After 9th year of formation of Party, The Party shall be bound to act on such a petition under this point of Party constitution. The entrepreneurs must conduct exemplary recorded discussions with all their employees on this subject and broadcast them live from their industries, showing 95% employee’s full support for such resolution being brought against Party.
 - Thereafter, these one hundred entrepreneurs shall hold online discussions in groups of ten with the Party founders once every week for four weeks (each entrepreneur or their designated company director, informed four days in advance, must personally attend all four sessions). Even after the Party founders are given the opportunity to present their views, if the 100 entrepreneurs, after using Grok Artificial Intelligence to evaluate their arguments, still believe the Party must be dissolved, then a final two-day discussion with everyone present together shall be held.
 - At the end of the second day, the founders **shall be bound to** announce the dissolution of the Party at a press conference.

 - **“People get leaders they deserve” is an oft-quoted saying and Party is committed to raising consciousness of country to such high standards that within reasonable period (of about ten years) of Party government Indians will feel the ground-level change, along with mind-level change within each strata of society.**

We commit ourselves to working with such pure ideological commitment, discipline, and accountability that if the people’s problems are not solved through our efforts, the entire

country will be convinced that those problems can never be solved by any other means. If the people truly desire real and concrete change, the responsibility now rests with them to stand firmly behind this Party that upholds uncompromising principles and offers a self-destruct guarantee in case it fails. **The duty to bring such a Party to power now lies with the citizens themselves**, if the people truly want change.

While many parties in the world function without including any such binding words in their constitutions and continue to exploit the public, the Party of Amazing Leaders/unique individuals will deliver unique performance and will make every word of the Preamble of the Indian Constitution a living reality.

After learning from years of observation and experience, the hard-learned lessons are openly written in this Party's Constitution. These truths may discomfort those who are accustomed to making compromises, but no one should take offense at the words or ideas contained herein. Our intention is to end the Kali Yuga (age of moral decline), and even the families of corrupt individuals will ultimately benefit from this transformation. It is our sincere hope that these words will be understood in the right spirit.

In case of any disputes regarding the detailed wording of the Party Constitution, a committee consisting of Samir Dudhgaonkar from Parbhani, Tatyasaheb Sapate from Jalna, Laxman Nalawade from Pune/Kolhapur, and Sudhir Hattangadi from Mumbai shall hold one-hour video conference discussions once every week until the dispute is resolved...!!

Every sentence and every clause of this Constitution shall be interpreted only in its pure, selfless spirit — never for the purpose of advancing selfish interests. Those who truly accept this principle are the real unique individuals with great leadership qualities. The Party of such Amazing Leaders/unique people is fully dedicated to building a nation worthy of India's thousands of years of glorious heritage — a truly ethical, happy, strong, and united nation.

General Provisions

Article I: Name and Headquarters of the Party

The name of the Party shall be “XYZ” (hereinafter referred to as “the Party”).

Headquarters

The permanent headquarters of the Party shall be located in Parbhani city, Maharashtra. Additional offices may be established in various places (talukas, districts, states, or abroad) as decided by the Central Executive Committee. **Party’s all decisions will be displayed online and expensive physical offices must be kept to a minimum.**

Article II: Fundamental Ideology of the Party

Inspired by the noble ideals of great visionaries ranging from Maharishi Valmiki till the founder of Hindavi Swaraj, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj & Delhi-Digvijay-Veer Maharaj Mahadji Shinde, the Party enters the political arena to immediately build a sovereign, just, and prosperous society. **British rule messed up Country badly hence the golden era of this period mentioned by the three names is what Party aims to rebuild/reclaim sans the evils of the period.**

The Party is committed to living and promoting the great principles drawn from all such Mahapurushas (great souls) or even the modern greats. History teaches us that when a king governed poorly, the people had no immediate alternative and were forced to wait decades or even centuries for a good ruler to emerge. This reality led to revolts and eventually laid the foundation of democracy in the quest for good governance, dignity, and fair treatment. **The world has approximately 2,000 years of experience with democracy.**

There is an urgent need for politicians with truly unique ideology to rein in such collusive leadership. Politics and social service exist not for personal enrichment but to secure a bright future for future generations and to ensure justice for all.

Since no one except the great historical figures appears to have truly worked on this principle, chaos has prevailed in every democracy across the world.

How will the Party translate this ideology into reality?

Every religion contains both good and some distortions created by vested interests. Our Party shall not promote any single religion. But it shall be the natural Party of those who believe in God/divine power. It shall be the Party of those who first give the highest priority to solving the complex, unsolved problems of social organization rather than getting matters complicated by getting into overly religious matters. This Party will be of those who possess the guts/willpower to solve complex problems.

Experience shows that politicians who gain power by inflaming Hindu-Muslim conflicts solve neither Hindu's nor Muslim's problems — instead, they milk the situation while appointing disreputable individuals as ministers in all this chaos. Therefore, this Party shall work relentlessly to defeat harmful tendencies, regardless of the caste or religion of the individuals involved.

It is often said that “Power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely” - to truly test a person's character, grant them unlimited power; their real character will be revealed by the decisions they make while holding that power. After extensive discussions with citizens who have experienced the selfish practices of elected representatives over two generations, we propose the following disciplined, transparent, and purpose-driven structure, Code of Conduct, and Permanent Manifesto.

Those who come together only for personal gain and pretend to be honest social-workers ultimately harm the collective good. **Our Party explicitly rejects and excludes all such harmful tendencies — and even more dangerous ones — directly through its Constitution with innovative structures.** It adopts a unique structure modelled on the Divine Lottery, community bhishi practices, and draw systems currently used in government for allotting MHADA homes. These structures provide bedrock for weeding out evil-social-workers while encouraging selfless service and transformative action.

Under this system, the question of unlimited power concentrating in any single individual simply does not arise. Only those who can function as a cohesive, unified team will feel good about this Party. Any sensible person understands that if the public grants power only to such large-hearted individuals, the nation's problems will be solved in shortest time

possible. Otherwise, the divisive politics of selfish leaders has already dragged the entire political system to rock bottom, as is evident today.

On the day any attempt is made to change this unique “Divine Lottery / draw / lottery-based selection process for all appointments,” **the person who formally proposes such a change shall be immediately expelled from the Party.** Even the one hundred entrepreneurs seeking dissolution of the Party shall not be permitted to cite the Divine Lottery system as a reason for dissolution.

The common practice in other parties of making changes every three years (or a quoted fixed period) creates factions and internal divisions. Organizations can only correct mistakes after the fixed period, during which time they remain stuck — causing immense damage to social work. **Therefore, in our Party, two or three shifts of office-bearers shall function, with one team active every ten to fifteen days.** This reduces the excessive importance attached to individual positions and automatically increases the importance of the Party modus operandi/Permanent Manifesto and the collective growth of the Party with laser-sharp focus. Mistakes made in one week can, if necessary, be corrected immediately in the following week. In short, two or three teams of office-bearers shall always be operational for every position.

If the ideals contained in the Party Constitution generate the unprecedented public response the Party expects, then three teams shall function for every position and committee — working the first few days, the middle days, and the final days of each month — delivering ideal structure/teamwork for fast-pacing transformation plans. Each team shall have full authority to take pending decisions. Instead of criticizing other office-bearers, every team is expected to focus on making whatever decisions are necessary during its ten/fifteen-day tenure to bring about radical transformation in the country.

This system will accelerate the goal of building an ideal nation and will prove wrong the notion that one must neglect one’s family to do social work. Women who have stayed away from politics due to its time-consuming processes will, because of this ideal system, encourage their own husbands to work for the Party, thereby increasing the participation of good people in politics.

- In the initial period, if sufficient personnel are not yet available, a single team shall work from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
- **The Party shall not enter into any pre-election alliances with any other party.**
- To immediately realize the dream of the nation envisioned by countless Mahapurushas, Party’s every public representative elected by the people, along with the Party itself, shall continuously implement innovative ideas. Article III

The Code of Conduct and Organizational Structure of the Party.

Executive Summary:

Party's own behaviour must strictly align with its fundamental ideology as well as Permanent Manifesto. The article creates a disciplined, transparent, and inclusive structure featuring multiple office-bearers per position (Primary + Alternate), strict term limits, a simple yet rigorous selection process using the Divine Lottery, and multiple specialized committees. It promotes work-life balance for leaders, limits the number of bank accounts, ensures financial discipline, and gives strong accountability mechanisms.

The Central Executive Committee is defined with balanced representation but caste system is never encouraged (including youth, farmers, women, neglected communities, and expert/spiritual advisors).

Decision-making is democratic with clear emergency powers, mandatory arbitration, and final interpretive authority vested in the founder Samir Ganesh Dudhgaonkar (Shinde) and people of his calibre/honest proven legacy. The entire framework is designed to prioritize honest action over empty titles, prevent corruption & dynastic tendencies, maintain transparency through public records & lotteries, and focus energy on solving national problems rather than internal power struggles.

Article IIIA:

Code of Conduct and Organizational Structure

The conduct of the Party itself must always remain fully consistent with the Party's ideology and Permanent Manifesto. Only the founders of the Party shall have the right to amend or correct any words in the Permanent Manifesto.

Code of Conduct for Principled Leadership and Governance:

1) Regarding Idealistic Leadership and Party Members.

The Party shall adopt the practice of selecting four or five individuals as Alternate office-bearers for every major position that exists in other parties. The exact number shall be decided by the Central Committee in its first meeting. No person may serve as National President more than two full terms of six years. However, under the lottery process

defined in **Article V**, that person's name may appear any number of times among the five Alternate Presidents.

- a) In the initial period, if sufficient personnel are not yet available, a single team shall work from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
- b) As soon as possible, two teams shall operate: one from the 1st to the 15th of the month, and the second from the 16th until the end of the month.
- c) If the Party receives an unprecedented public response, three committees shall be activated (1st–10th, 11th–20th, and 21st until the end of the month) as necessary to provide prompt service to the people.
 1. Party functionaries may be granted continuous family leave for ten to fifteen days. Even during the days spent with family, they are expected to use part of that time **ONLY** for online meetings related to upcoming responsibilities. **This system will end the notion that one must neglect one's home in order to do politics. As a direct result, well-educated individuals who currently stay away from politics will be encouraged to participate.**
 2. **The Party shall maintain only three bank accounts: the Main Account, the Election Account, and a Donation Receipt Account. These accounts shall be used strictly in accordance with their names to fulfil the Party's goals and policies.**
 - a. From the Main Account, interest-free loans (within prescribed limits & after voting about such request in central committee meeting) may be extended to individuals working on the Central Committee. Such loans must be repaid by the end of the committee's term.
 - b. No person may become a member of any other party until the loan is fully repaid.

The following shall be considered Party members:

- **All founders of the Party. (Only these individuals shall have the right to amend the Party Constitution except the Divine Lottery method of selections.)**
- **Members of the Central Executive Committee.**
- **Fee-paying Party members, who shall have the right to propose any positive agenda item at the biannual (online or offline) general meetings. These fees shall be deposited into the Party's Main Bank Account.**
 - Persons seeking membership must send a concise email to the Party stating their acceptance of the Party's ideology, structure and Manifesto points. A reply confirming acceptance shall constitute formal approval of membership. **This process shall be legally binding on all under the Party Constitution.**
- **General members** – those who do not pay fees and have no voting rights. An email expressing desire to participate as general member shall serve as legal evidence of acceptance of the Party Constitution.

- **No Party member shall simultaneously be a member of any other political party or affiliated organization.**

Duties of the Party’s Supreme Leadership:

Every National President and General Secretary during their respective shift shall be expected to:

- **Maintain** continuous online and offline public contact with communities, resolve their grievances, and lift them out of despair.
- **Identify** critical problems during such public outreach and direct the Working Committee to prioritize them. (The Working Committee, after discussion with Grok Artificial Intelligence and expert panels, shall determine the exact nature of the issue or problem. Action on that issue shall then be mandatory for all Party members.) In this manner, Party leadership shall channel the voice of the people into the Party, everyday!! Real-time demands..!
- **Act** as a selfless guardian of the public, giving unwavering attention to their needs — in the same way a responsible family head cares for a joint family.
- **Resolve**, within three days, any complaints against office-bearers, members, or public representatives who fail to uphold the Party’s ideals and ensure immediate accountability.

This commitment to swift decision-making distinguishes the Party’s approach, builds public trust, and empowers Party members to fulfil their responsibilities with confidence.

B) Organizational Structure:

To focus on meaningful action rather than meaningless branding of Party posts, the Party shall adopt a well-organized structure modelled on effective political organizations, **while placing the strongest emphasis on honesty and impact.**

The selection of every individual in the Party shall be strictly governed by the candidate eligibility principles outlined in **Articles IV and V** of this Constitution and shall be conducted through the Divine Lottery process.

i. Central Committee – Leadership Hierarchy

The Party’s leadership shall function under the National President through the Central Committee. This Committee shall be responsible for appointing Regional Chiefs, Divisional Chiefs, District Chiefs, Taluka Chiefs, Circle Chiefs, and Booth-level Chiefs. Each higher committee shall be responsible for constituting the committee immediately below it.

- a. The authority to call Party meetings shall rest with the National President / four Alternate Presidents and the General Secretary.**

To ensure candidate suitability and fairness, this Committee shall operate in accordance with **Articles IV and V** of the Party Constitution.

- 1) **Recognizing the strength of this unique process**, immediately after Party registration, the process of declaring candidates for upcoming elections shall begin without delay.
 - a) Other parties announce candidates at the last minute to prevent rebellion. However, because our Party's inclusive system grants Alternate MLA-level status, the impact of rebellion will be negligible. There is therefore no need to keep aspirants waiting. The process of declaring Alternate Candidates shall begin promptly, allowing teams of ten to twenty people to thoroughly work every constituency and carry the Party's goals and policies to every village and hamlet.
 - b) By communicating the strength of the Party modus operandi & Permanent Manifesto to the public for solving public's everyday issues, despair in the country will decrease and positivity will increase, marking the beginning of real societal change.
 - c) **The names of individuals who have deposited the prescribed Party fund into the Main Account shall be published on the Party website every Monday as Alternate Candidates. All possible channels shall be used to publicize these names.**
 - d) **If the conduct and statements of all aspirants and Alternate Candidates remain appropriate, then** this committee will select the candidate who will file the Election Commission form shall be conducted, on-camera in the month prior to the election announcement, via the Divine Lottery process.

iii. Working Committee Responsibilities:

- a) Selection of major issues from the Manifesto & Ensuring coordinated implementation of the Party's agenda
- b) Planning of initiatives and programs
- c) Determining the number of persons (based on the scale of the election) to be included in the Divine Lottery
- d) selecting names from active Party workers, in collaboration with respective local teams, using Grok AI type reliable AI tools
- e) Sending a letter every Friday to the Website Committee regarding the uploading of names. This letter must bear the mandatory signatures of the Central Committee President and General Secretary.

iv. Discipline Committee: Dedicated to ensuring compliance with the Party's ideals and Code of Conduct, and to maintaining organizational discipline.

- a) Keep watch on Party member's/workers activities and discipline those who need it.
- b) **Formation of committees** aligned with the ideal social structure expected in the country, and appointment of their office-bearers.
- c) **No committee shall be formed on the basis of caste.** However, every committee shall be divided into three sub-groups operating on the 1st–10th, 11th–20th, and 21st until the end of the month. The Discipline Committee shall ensure inclusiveness is maintained in every committee.
 - a. Until sufficient personnel are available, a single committee shall function at start.

Examples of Committees:

- Ministry Oversight Committee
- International Affairs Committee

- Small Entrepreneurs Committee
- Agriculture Committee
- Labor Committee

- Youth Committee
- Women’s Committee
- Men’s Committee
- Education Committee
- Government Employees Committee

- Private Sector Employees Committee
- Large Entrepreneurs Committee
- Investment Committee
- Innovative Topics Committee

- d) **The Party is bound to resolve complaints received via email from workers within one week. Resolution shall preferably occur through immediate video calls. This Committee shall oversee such matters.**
- e) **The Committee responsible for immediately expelling any person who makes public statements deviating from the Manifesto points. Every individual shall be allowed two mistakes/e-mail warnings.**
 - c. **After the third mistake**, the Committee shall have the authority to expel the individual without further chances. The names of expelled persons shall be published on the Party website along with a 1,000-word explanation of their violations.

v. Publicity Committee: Focused on strategic communication, public relations, and spreading the Party’s vision and successes to increase public participation.

- a) This Committee shall be responsible for ensuring that all information appears on the website by 10:00 AM every Monday. Lists of names and committee details shall be uploaded to the website every Friday.
- b) In every public meeting, Star Campaigners, District Presidents, Divisional Chiefs, and the candidate shall definitely speak. In addition, two names shall be drawn by lottery from the Alternate Candidates and two from the next twenty workers in the list to deliver speeches. This will allow new people to speak on Manifesto points in their own style in every meeting.
 - a. While everyone wishes to speak, capable individuals are often deliberately sidelined by jealous office-bearers in traditional politics. This shall never be tolerated in our Party.

During election periods, all Central Committee members (regardless of shift) are granted the constitutional right to travel and speak. This will ensure well-organized meetings, give

many people the opportunity to express ideas, and keep many senior office-bearers available for meetings.

Speaking time limits shall be as follows:

- i. Star Campaigners: as much time as required; District Presidents and Divisional Chiefs: 8–10 minutes each; Candidate: 13–15 minutes.
- ii. Four persons from the top thirty names in that area shall be granted three minutes each to speak.
- iii. These speeches shall begin immediately after the Star Campaigner pays respects to historical figures upon arrival.
- iv. Selection of four speakers shall be done by the Star Campaigner drawing lots from a transparent box in which aspirants have personally deposited their own chits. **Two chits shall be drawn from two separate boxes — one containing names of Alternate Candidates and the other containing names of workers.**

ii) In addition to those selected to speak, any two persons from the top thirty may travel in the Star Campaigner’s vehicle that day within the constituency. The vehicle shall carry the District Chief, Divisional Chief, and these two new individuals.

vi. Prosperity Committee: A unique institutional mechanism for advancing social welfare.

- A. Organize monthly online and quarterly offline discussions among twenty to thirty beneficiaries of the Party’s schemes and thought-leaders, to inspire/secure their participation in community upliftment.**
 - a. Encourage beneficiaries to contribute to collective welfare and promote initiatives that keep individuals away from addictions, thereby building a healthier and more engaged society.
- B. Anyone wishing to work in the Party must rise from the bottom upward.** Only those who publicly announce (preferably through social media) and successfully organize “Party Policy and Beneficiary Dialogue Programs” for groups of twenty/thirty people in at least fifty locations/villages shall be eligible to advance in the process for Party positions.
- C. Only individuals who have worked for three months on any committee and have posted Party-policies/modus Operandi on the X application using the Party’s designated tag shall be considered for candidate selection.**
 - a. In the initial period before the Party is big, direct appointments may be made. From the second year after registration, people shall be evaluated as explained in this point of committee.
 - b. In the beginning, before joining the Party, aspirants must post couple of self-drafted ideological posts or own-videos per week on social media (boosted for that taluka) in line with Party ideology for one month. Only then shall they be considered for candidate selection.

- D. **Using Grok AI, a summary of each worker's or aspirant's performance shall be generated and used to decide their placement in the next committee.** The AI report shall be displayed on a large screen visible to all. Decisions shall be made fairly according to the report, without bias.

By adhering to honest conduct and a well-structured Constitution, the Party shall direct its energy toward meaningful action, maintaining relentless focus on accountability, discipline, and public welfare. **This structure will enable the Party to effectively realize its vision of a just, prosperous, and united nation.**

C) Central Executive Committee, Term, and Powers

The Central Executive Committee shall be the supreme decision-making body of the Party and shall ensure balanced representation and democratic governance. The thirty-member structure shall be as follows:

1. National President (Chairman): Shall serve as the primary leader and public face of the Party.
2. Four National Vice-Presidents
3. General Secretary (Organizational): Responsible for overseeing the Party's operations, coordination, and implementation of decisions.
4. Four Secretaries
5. Treasurer: Responsible for financial management of the Party; shall ensure transparency and compliance with legal requirements. Only a person with experience in this field may hold this position
6. Three Regional Representatives: Selected from regional chief workers; shall represent diverse geographical interests and ensure equal attention to regional issues
7. Two Youth Representatives: Shall ensure inclusion of young voices and perspectives
8. Two Farmer Representatives: Selected through Party-affiliated farmers' organizations; shall advocate for agricultural interests
9. Two Women Representatives: Shall ensure gender equality and representation of women's issues
10. Seven Representatives from Neglected Communities: Shall represent Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and other neglected groups to ensure inclusiveness
11. Three Experts: Drawn from fields such as industry, education, or civil society; shall provide special guidance during global emergencies, wars, or sanctions
12. Spiritual Advisors: Shall include representatives from both majority and minority faiths to provide moral guidance. They shall participate in every discussion but shall have no voting rights. The Committee shall be bound to give due consideration to their views
 - a) Both categories of advisors shall be selected every three years. The Central Committee shall change every six years, but advisors shall be rotated every three years. Advisors will attend all meetings during their 3-year term, irrespective of which shift of central/state executive committee is in power. They get to see all three batches of committee's running the Party and they may report their views to Party founders.

D) Elections and Terms of Office

- 1. Every committee shall have a term of six years.**
 - The National President shall serve as Chairman of Central Committee; the General Secretary shall serve as Vice-Chairman.
 - In the Party's first year, direct appointments shall be made to the empty positions of Central Committee and State Committees by the founders, based on Grok AI reports. Decision of Party Founder's will be binding on Party for first year committee formations.
2. From second year, Vacant positions shall be filled through interim elections as per Party's Modus Operandi or nominations by the Central Committee and shall be presented for approval by the Discipline Committee at the next biannual National Conference.
3. Once the Party grows larger, all committee members shall be selected through a transparent Divine Lottery at the National Conference.
- 4. No person may hold the same position for more than two terms (twelve years), and the terms cannot be consecutive. There shall be no term limit for serving as an Alternate Representative for the same post. Abuse of power given to Alternate Representatives will not be tolerated by Party.** They must use the power of Party constitution for the goals of Party and not for personal enrichment.
 - Similar committees shall function at the state, divisional, district, taluka, circle, and booth levels.
- 5. The appointment of advisors and experts shall be the responsibility of individuals with people having character-rich backgrounds/legacy and personal achievements,** such as likes of Samir Ganeshrao Dudhgaonkar (Shindeshahi-Raut), Arvind Shivajirao Nade (Murud), Arun Chandrakant Tavare (Baramati), Utpal Manohar Parrikar, Samir Kakodkar (both from Goa), and Krantisinh Parihar (Madhya Pradesh).
 - The permanent responsibility of preparing and maintaining the list of persons with **character-rich backgrounds/legacy and personal achievements** is hereby assigned to Samir Ganeshrao Dudhgaonkar (Shinde).
 - **Brief information about Samir:** He is M.S. Mech Engg from USA, a sober member of a family with 150 years of character-rich legacy. He played a major role in getting approval for the "Magel Tyala Solar Krishi Pump Yojana," **the scheme that helped place Maharashtra's name in the Guinness Book.** He was directly involved in the approval of the scheme in state budget of 2015 and full-scaling of scheme after Lok Sabha results in June 2024. This authority shall remain with him as long as his conduct continues to meet the high standards expected of nation-builders'.
- 6. The final authority to interpret the words and true spirit of this Constitution shall rests with Samir Dudhgaonkar. Any person who has issues with constitutional points, after extensive discussion (including up to three days of meetings if**

necessary) and after presenting Grok AI backed well-researched arguments, still refuses to accept the decision of the Discipline Committee and Samir Dudhgaonkar shall be immediately expelled from the Party. Such person is nothing more than a trouble-maker, hence this constitutional provision. If the person has a valid point then it shall be incorporated in constitution.!!

7. All internal disputes must first undergo mandatory arbitration. Persons who refuse to accept the decision of Samir Dudhgaonkar and the arbitration panel shall have no right to approach the courts.

- Court access shall be allowed only after the judicial system clears its backlog of five crore pending cases and begins delivering judgments within one year. Until such conditions exist, the decisions of Samir Dudhgaonkar and the arbitration panel shall be binding on all Party members.
- **In short, individuals who do not accept these unique principles should not work in this Party;** they should form their own party and prove their intelligence by growing that Party.
- Once the Party grows large, any attempt to capture it will be identified early and neutralized through these constitutional provisions.

Emergency Powers:

In cases of national or state-level emergencies, internal crises, or major external challenges called Acts of God (such as natural disasters or political instability), the Party Founders or Central Committee shall have discretionary authority to take urgent decisions, subject to the following restrictions:

1. Approval by a three-fourths majority of voting members in that meeting.
 - a. **Mandatory review and ratification of all emergency decisions at the next National Conference or within six months, whichever is earlier. Video Conference is permitted as valid means of meeting for such ratification.**
2. Transparent communication of emergency decisions to Party members and the public must be made, **to maintain trust and accountability.**
3. **The Divine Lottery process shall not be altered under any circumstances. Direct appointments (limited to six months) may be made during Acts of God/emergencies.**

Meetings and Decision-Making:

- The Committee shall hold monthly online meetings and quarterly offline meetings.
 - Additional meetings may be called by the National President or upon request by one-third of the members.

- Decisions shall be taken by simple majority of those present, except for constitutional amendments or emergency powers, which require a three-fourths majority. If any member demands a vote on an issue, a secret ballot shall be mandatory.
- **The Party shall maintain a Pro-Constitution on its website.** If the founders or the Central Committee later after Party formation determine that any issue is of critical importance, it shall be treated as part of the Manifesto in this Pro-Constitution Document.
- Meetings may be held in person or virtually to ensure attendance. Minutes shall be published publicly (on the website, Instagram, and X app) within fifteen days of the meeting to maintain transparency.
 - All meetings of the Central Committee and Regional Committees shall be audio-recorded and preferably live-streamed. This shall be the highest standard of transparency and a simple way to record the efforts of the people for history.

This structure ensures a democratic, inclusive, and efficient supreme body that maintains a proper balance of representation, expertise, and accountability, thereby enabling the Party to effectively realize its vision of a just and prosperous nation.

The words of this Constitution shall always be interpreted while preserving their true spirit and intent — never for the purpose of advancing selfish interests.

Article IV

Party's Permanent Modus Operandi

Essence of Article IV: Party's Permanent Modus Operandi

Article IV establishes the Party's core operational system — its “Permanent Modus Operandi” — for candidate selection and day-to-day functioning. At its heart is a revolutionary, fully transparent Divine Lottery (Ishwari Chitti) system, modelled on the corruption-free MHADA housing lottery and traditional community bhishi practices. This system aims to end dynastic politics, ticket manipulation, corruption, and the culture of “**once elected, stay forever without working.**”

Instead of the usual single-ticket, winner-takes-all model, the Party fields multiple qualified candidates (4–19 per seat, depending on the election) for every position. One becomes the Primary Representative (Corporator/MLA/MP), while the rest serve as Alternate or Deputy Representatives with real, binding authority. This ensures that many honest, capable citizens — including ordinary people and their future generations — gain a permanent, meaningful role in decision-making rather than being shut out forever, guaranteeing that even ordinary honest citizens and their future generations get a fair, ongoing role in decision-making.

This approach will help in maintaining longest running, happy democracy in India. Not something like USA who can't pay its bills in 250th year of their democracy. Refer www.USDebtClock.org

After Party registration, the process has following parts :-

- public debates to rank merit of probable Party candidates,
- mandatory financial contributions from all aspirants (creating collective “bhishi-style” funding that keeps elections inexpensive and fair),
- and a strict wealth-donation requirement for anyone with a questionable public-service background.
 - o Direct candidacy is available for those offering innovative national ideas, but even they must listen to the Alternate Representatives.
- **The lottery Modus Operandi itself is declared unamendable; any attempt to alter it results in immediate expulsion from Party.**
- Accountability is ironclad: if the Party or elected representative fails in duty, 100+ citizen complaints or Alternate Representatives' formal grievance to Party can force resignation after due process.

In essence, **Article IV** replaces dynastic politics, ticket manipulation, and the “once elected, stay forever without working” culture with a system of continuous collective service, radical inclusiveness, and selfless teamwork. **It guarantees that power is never concentrated in one individual and that the Party's representatives remain permanently answerable to both the people and the Party's founding principles. This unique mechanism is designed to deliver genuine, corruption-free transformation from the very first day the Party is registered.** Emphasizes selfless service and includes strong accountability mechanisms so that elected representatives remain answerable to the Party and the people.

Modus Operandi of the Party

Executive Summary

This section outlines the core Modus Operandi of the Party. It shall be referred to as the “Permanent Modus Operandi.”

Why should only a few candidates compete for a single seat in municipal elections under the ward system with reservation provisions, while inclusivity for higher positions (MLA/MP) remains a distant dream?? Most MLA/MP positions go only to majority caste of any constituency. **Is that fair? Of course, No..!**

Keeping in mind this inclusive principle, the Party adopts an alternative system in which multiple public servants shall be selected for each single position. If country’s citizen who are tired of all-party collusion and nepotism in each conventional party, give this Party an unprecedented response, **then even in open constituencies the Divine Lottery system will ensure that neglected sections of society finally gain their rightful place in the decision-making process, even on non-reserved seats — a right they never have received or ever will since India’s Independence.**

Through this mechanism, the prevailing culture of **“do no work, do rampant corruption, engage in conspiracies, but remain in power permanently”** will come to an end. **By creating positions such as Alternate MLA / Alternate MP, deserving families and individuals will be able to secure a permanent, rightful place in both positions of power and the decision-making process, even while facing competition.** The public will finally be freed from inefficient and thoughtless but cruel/conniving leaders.

The Party hereby adopts this ideology to immediately curb corrupt tendencies during candidature selection.

As mentioned earlier, recognizing the strength of this unique process, immediately after the Party is registered, it shall begin the process of declaring candidates for all upcoming elections. Unlike other parties that announce candidates at the last minute to prevent rebellion, this Party — because its unique system renders rebellion ineffective — has no need to keep aspirants waiting.

Candidate declaration shall therefore begin promptly, allowing teams of ten people each to thoroughly work every constituency. The process of transforming society shall begin immediately.

The Party shall function strictly according to the following principles. **Not for selfish gain, but solely for the greater public good, through a truly unique vision!**

A. Candidate Selection Process

Candidates must demonstrate a clear commitment to selfless public service. Every citizen — especially those who are selfless and actively contribute — has the right to an opportunity for candidacy. The selection process is modelled on the corruption-free lottery system of the Maharashtra Housing and Area Development Authority (MHADA) and socially accepted practices such as the distribution of agricultural equipment. **Anyone who rejects this transparent method will immediately be recognized as acting out of self-interest.**

After the death of the great leader Manohar Parrikar, his highly educated son Utpal Manohar Parrikar — who built a successful career in the computer field in the United States — was denied candidature, which globally was seen as a grave injustice. Similarly, after Shri Nandkumar Singh Chouhan served as Madhya Pradesh Party President, his son was sidelined.

Such treatment is an insult to the life-long commitment & legacies of these leaders. In response to such prevalent mis-treatment of honest leaders in all parties, this Party shall be constitutionally bound to grant a permanent place in its decision-making process to the disciplined, highly educated, and hardworking next-generation members of leader's families (those who have worked hard for the Party and reached the level of Alternate MLA or Alternate MP).



However, if the next generation **of Party leaders** has wasted its opportunities, has bad character or have fallen by the wayside, they will not automatically receive such positions. **In any case, such individuals automatically get filtered out during the debate process and public scrutiny before they can become representatives.** Through this system, the common injustice done to dedicated workers in other parties will not occur here.

This modus Operandi allows Party workers to focus on genuine public service and on earning their place in the lottery & never focus on utilising corrupt means for getting candidatures. The current corrupt practice — of pretending to be a loyal worker to a hard-working/honest powerful leader, then stabbing him in the back by paying money to party-leadership for snatching candidature for oneself — **will no longer be necessary.**

1. Preliminary Screening:-

At every level of the Party, selection shall be conducted through a transparent process that includes public disclosure of qualifications and an independent review by a committee to ensure compliance with the conditions specified in this **Article IV**.

The Party's direct candidature pointers:

- (i) **Wealth Donation:** Individuals or families who have become wealthy through usurping government funds while delivering substandard work, or those who have allegedly held public office & have used their positions for personal enrichment by accumulating disproportionate wealth, **shall be required — as a test of honesty — to donate half of their personal wealth to public welfare every five years before being given any opportunity. Those who do so shall be declared candidates directly on the first occasion.** From the second instance onward, their names shall be permanently included in the Divine lottery process.
 1. If multiple honest candidates fulfil this condition, selection among them shall be made through a transparent lottery system.
 2. The donation amount must be substantial (at least several lakh rupees). Anyone attempting to gain opportunity through dramatic but insincere donations shall be immediately expelled from the Party.
 - a. The person who provides written proof exposing such insincerity of candidate shall, with their consent, have their name included in the lottery directly (without paying their election funds amount share for such lottery). **Though, such person must give their share of party-funds in party's main bank account.**
 3. If any candidate is unwilling to donate half of their wealth, only those who have performed at least four to five years of selfless, unpaid (voluntary) community service in applicable constituency shall be eligible for the lottery-based selection process.
- ii. Candidates who propose innovative ideas that is assured to have grown/aided national prosperity shall be **granted direct candidacy once**, provided they meet the preconditions in **Articles IV and V**. Even if such individuals can proudly call themselves MLA or MP, they shall be required to listen to the Alternate MLA / Alternate MP (and similar positions) of a small number of other qualified candidates who could also have been selected through the lottery.
- iii. **Every 6th such idea earns the person a direct candidature of their liking. This provision is made for keeping innovative minds within our Party only. 😊**

2. Transparent Lottery System:

To ensure fairness and eliminate corruption, the Party at all levels shall use a transparent Divine Lottery (Ishwari Chitti) system inspired by the corruption-free MHADA housing lottery and socially accepted practices such as the distribution of agricultural equipment through draws. In some district central cooperative bank director elections, ties have been resolved by a coin toss or Divine Lottery. Community “bhishi” systems involving both men & women groups separately, are already widely accepted.

Those who accept these high-quality principles in the process of public service are truly unique individuals — and this Party belongs to exactly such people. Not for selfish gain, but solely for the greater good, through a unique vision!

- a) **Lottery-Based Selection:** After preliminary screening, if direct candidacy is not granted, candidates shall be selected from among qualified aspirants through a transparent Divine Lottery structure to prevent the financial manipulation commonly seen in other parties and to uphold undisputed fairness.

This part of the Constitution shall never be amended, as it preserves the Party’s integrity, spotless transparency and inclusiveness. Any person attempting to change this process shall be immediately expelled from the Party, and all available media shall be used to publicly shame the names of such selfish individuals so that citizens clearly understand their true intentions. Even if they join other parties, the public will be able to isolate them & throw them out of social life.

While the Party itself may one day be dissolved, this fair Divine Lottery + bhishi-style selection and ticket distribution process shall never be altered.

- b) Any person wishing to have their name included in the lottery must first deposit the prescribed Party fund amount into the main account and the prescribed election contribution amount into the Party’s election account (this shall be used for the campaign of the candidate whose name is drawn, as per Election Commission Model Code of conduct point about candidate expenditure limit).
1. **Collective Funding for Elections:** Funding shall come from the collective contributions of qualified candidates. **This will establish in politics — in an unprecedented way — the highly effective “bhishi” model already used by the public** (for example, limiting per-person expenditure to around fifteen (5 election fund +10 party fund per candidate) lakh rupees per Assembly seat & MP seat. This unique method will encourage participation by ordinary citizens in elections (which are normally driven away from entire expensive process of elections) besides making the process transparent & fair.
 2. Because of this, the Party expects unprecedented support from people who are tired of all existing parties and politicians.
- c) **Role of Those Not picked in the Lottery:** Qualified candidates whose name is not picked in the lottery but are considered essential for electoral success shall

serve as Deputy Representatives or Alternate Representatives. They shall work alongside the lottery-selected candidate to bring about radical, fundamental change in India and to fulfil the Party's objectives.

1. Letters and demands from Deputy Representatives on public works and important issues shall be binding on the elected representative. If Deputy Representatives file a complaint with the Discipline Committee stating that "the lottery-selected candidate is not performing his/her duties or is not giving in to official demands of alternate representative," then the Party shall, after the Discipline Committee's decision, ask the elected candidate's immediate resignation. **It shall be the responsibility of the winning candidate — whose victory was made possible by collective effort — not to make life difficult for those who helped him/her.**
2. Individuals may serve as Alternate Representatives for many years, thereby gaining the right — through the lottery process — to serve up to ten terms without interruption.

Recognizing the strength of this pioneering process, immediately after Party registration, the process of declaring candidates for upcoming elections shall begin.

B. Party/Candidate Accountability Mechanism:

If any elected or selected representative, having reached a high position; due to the influence of Party Modus Operandi, Party Manifesto points, Party leaders or workers; displays unacceptable behaviour and

1. receives more than one hundred written complaints from sober, tax-paying, good citizens who are Party members, (organic complaints, not planned toolkit type issue)
2. if one hundred people who have regularly propagated the Party's Manifesto points on the X application (or similar ideas) meet the Party leader to register their grievances, then
 - a) after holding comprehensive discussions for three days, the Party leader's decision regarding that office-bearer/candidate shall be implemented immediately.
 - b) **If the issue still persists despite this process, the provisions of Article III.D.6/7 shall become mandatory.**

Summary of the Transparent Selection Process rampantly used by Communities for Many Generations:

Objective:

To ensure fairness, inclusiveness, and transparency in candidate selection, to prevent **allegations of favouritism** within the Party, and to maintain unity, a lottery-based system inspired by the MHADA housing lottery and the Divine Lottery distribution of agricultural equipment shall be implemented. For a political party, this is an unprecedented method which guarantees “decisive rights / representation for every community in the decision-making process in every election.”

Only people with truly selfless and ethical thinking accept such a system. The public knows that only such individuals can truly serve the people’s interest — and that is why the Party expects an unprecedented response from fellow-country-men.

As outlined in next Article’s story about Elon Musk - Musk emphasizes: “Are they a good person? Trustworthy, smart, talented, and hardworking? If yes, you can teach them domain knowledge later. But those fundamental traits, you cannot change.” This is precisely why Elon Musk’s teams execute at exceptional speed and effectiveness.

Multiple contributors with sound fundamental traits (for example, ten persons for one seat) will significantly enhance efficiency/delivery on manifesto promises.

Process Steps:

1. The Party’s selection committee for election-at-hand shall identify, for each seat, hardworking, capable (both financially and ideologically sound), and qualified candidates (from among those who have deposited the prescribed contribution).
 - A. **Inspired by the ward system**, the Party shall field four to nineteen candidates (the exact number to be decided by the Central Committee) for each seat. Their names shall go into a draw to select the final candidate.
 - i. For Assembly seats, eleven names shall be taken; for Parliamentary seats, nineteen names shall be selected. The Central Committee shall determine the number of candidates to be selected per constituency and the contribution amount, depending on the scale of the election.
 - ii. **Party Founders will communicate the amount to interested candidates in a way that doesn’t violate country’s laws.**
 - B. List shall be prepared of those who accept the lottery process and deposit the prescribed contribution amounts into the Party’s main bank account and election account.
2. Public debate sessions shall be organized with all shortlisted aspirants/candidates to determine their relative merit ranking.
3. In a joint meeting, the Central Committee members or person designated by Party Founders shall clearly communicate that the candidate picked up in the lottery shall serve as the Primary Representative (e.g., Corporator / MLA / MP), while the others shall serve as Alternate Representatives or Deputy Representatives. Everyone will be

re-assured that every qualified candidate gets an opportunity to contribute and how this process automatically excludes selfish individuals who believe “**everything is meant to enrich my family alone.**”

- A. **The picked name** will be bound implement public service initiatives proposed by the Alternate Representatives, Picked name should have no issue in doing public good without worrying about who gets the credit since his election win was made possible through collective unity and contributions of all representatives.
 - B. If the picked representative fails in this duty and a decision goes against him/her after following the prescribed Party process, he/she shall be required to resign and shall be expelled from the Party.
4. The Party leader shall publicly announce the candidate picked through the transparent lottery and shall call upon all candidates to collectively support the election campaign.
 - A. If the selected candidate suddenly develops cold feet and tries to push another name forward, a fresh lottery shall be conducted to select the replacement. **The contribution shall not be refunded in such cases. The person who steps back still continues serving the public as an Alternate Representative causing no losses to him.**
 5. Alternate Representatives shall work in complete unity with the lottery picked representative. Appointments to government positions shall be made according to the order decided by the people debate, and more ensuing opportunities coming later will be extended to other loyal Party workers. **This will ensure efficient resolution of common challenge found in other political parties** – a method/structure of giving justice to loyal foot-soldiers and go onto solve public problems on fast-track.
 6. When the Party forms the government, ministerial positions shall be allotted through lottery picked among Central Committee members, outstanding party workers relevant to where govt is formed, relevant Party office-bearers, and the elected representatives. Party Founders will have final say in how to go about doing this. Those whose names are not drawn for ministerial posts from the list prepared by Party Founders, shall be given the status of Alternate Minister, and ministers shall be bound to listen to them. This structure is created not to cause chaos but to ensure accountability/checks & balance system is inbuilt amongst hard-working foot-soldiers. None of this can be used to stop elected candidate from functioning. Anyone found using this structure of Party to create hassles for elected candidates will be strictly dealt with.
 7. Individuals may serve as Alternate Representatives for many years. **Through the Divine Lottery process that forms the foundation of this Party, a person shall have the right to serve the nation continuously for up to ten terms without interruption.**
 - A. **Even people who change parties for selfish reasons — and their next generations — shall receive the best opportunities ONLY in this Party.** Since this is the only Party that offers a structure/system in which hard work by one generation secures decision-making roles for capable, educated members of future generations; the Party & its workers will remain fully focused on achieving

permanent victory in every election besides execution of manifesto for earning permanent good-will among Voters.

- i. For Party-hoppers, this modus operandi will protect their own long-term interests across generations as well. **The opportunity for one individual or family to become Alternate MLA or Alternate MP fifty times is not only unprecedented but has never existed before in history.**
8. If an elected representative who benefits from the Party's progress neglects his/her duties, the Party leader/committee — after following the process outlined in **Part B of this Article** — shall hold a collective meeting/assembly with all concerned stakeholders and take a binding decision. This will free the time of Central Committee leaders for important work and prevent leadership from being overburdened by individual public complaints.

Article V

Ideology and Eligibility Criteria for Party Candidates and Ticket Aspirants

Summary:-

This section of Article V outlines the Party's strict, high-integrity ideology and selection process for candidates and ticket aspirants. It draws heavily from Elon Musk's emphasis on hiring people with talent, drive, trustworthiness, and especially "goodness of heart" rather than talent alone **or in other words draws from great thoughts all legends' promoted since time immemorial.**

The Party commits to selecting only individuals of exceptional moral character, proven public service, and genuine selflessness. It introduces a unique "Divine Lottery" (Ishwari Chitti) system combined with public debates, nominal financial contributions for election expenses, asset disclosures and rigorous candidate eligibility criteria to ensure transparency, prevent corruption and give ordinary honest citizens a real chance at leadership. **This draws inspiration from some conditions that are put in Article 102, Article 173, Article 191 of Indian constitution for MP's & state legislatures respectively.**

Special rules exclude or restrict government employees, their families, political dynasties, and certain professionals to avoid conflicts of interest or immediate loss of life. **The overall goal is to create a political party structure/modus operandi** that truly serves the people, breaks traditional corrupt practices, and builds a system where only good-hearted, hardworking, and principled individuals rise to power.

Details:-

A. Core Philosophy for Party Candidates and Those Seeking Party candidature:-

The Party fully adopts the following principles inspired by Elon Musk:

Elon Musk has stated: "The biggest mistake I made is to put too much weighting on somebody's talent and not enough on their personality. It actually matters whether somebody has a good heart."

Elon Musk's core philosophy for building world-class teams is straightforward: "If somebody gets things done, I love them." He hires for four essential traits:

- Talent
- Drive
- Trustworthiness
- **Goodness of heart (which he has acknowledged underweighting in the past)**

Musk emphasizes: "Are they a good person? Trustworthy, smart, talented, and hardworking? If yes, you can teach them domain knowledge later. But those fundamental traits, you cannot change."

This is precisely why Elon Musk’s teams execute at exceptional speed and effectiveness.

The Party therefore places special emphasis on cultivating good values, strong character, and a disciplined, addiction-free life among its members and future leaders. When such values are instilled, individuals earn respect, success, and meaningful opportunities in both professional and public life — a truth proven through real-world experience in industry and leadership.

Party is committed to building a structure for filtering out ill-intentioned from all social-workers. Guided by timeless principles, the Party hereby adopts the following standard structure. The Party is committed to selecting candidates who uphold the highest ethical standards expected of public servants. **Good people do good work; those who merely pretend, no matter how high their position, ultimately harm the public.**

To ensure that candidates truly represent the Party’s values and the people’s expectations, the following mandatory pre-conditions must be fulfilled. Any person who deliberately misleads the Party or lies on any of the following matters shall be immediately expelled from the Party. The person providing credible evidence of such falsehood of the concerned expelled-Party leader shall be given priority for the resulting vacant positions (without paying the election fund for that position).

The Party’s own conduct must always remain fully consistent with its permanent Manifesto.

Eligibility for Those Seeking a Party candidature:-

1. **Moral and Intellectual Capacity:** Candidates must possess strong moral character and sensitivity beyond mere educational qualifications.
 - A. **They must demonstrate proficiency only in communication, reading, writing, and basic mathematics in local language & Hindi/English — these shall be the only subjects tested.**
 - B. **Physical and Mental Fitness:** Candidates must pass a fitness test and a psychological evaluation to ensure they are physically and mentally fit for public office.
 - C. **Continuous Learning:** To demonstrate ongoing intellectual development, candidates must provide evidence of having attended at least one full-length lecture or discourse per month over a recent period of five years, along with their public social media comments or reflections after each such participation.
 - D. **Hardworking and Virtuous Character:** **The Party’s ideology holds that** an honest, hardworking person with limited formal education is always preferable to a highly educated PhD holder with greedy or corrupt tendencies. Candidates must demonstrate a history of diligence, freedom from addiction, selfless conduct, and no record of exploiting others’ property.

- i. **Honesty and Ethical Conduct:** Candidates must show a consistent five-year history free from charges of corruption, fraud, or moral turpitude, supported by credible evidence. For candidates from old political families, an unblemished record going back to the time of India's Independence shall be considered ideal.
 - E. **Adherence to Ideal Principles:** Candidates must provide evidence that they have studied and promoted ideal principles drawn from the lives of great historical figures, that they have lived by those principles, and that they have repeatedly encouraged inclusiveness and lifelong commitment to social welfare on social media over the past five years.
 - i. **Mandatory Opposition to Corrupt Figures:** Candidates must provide evidence of having publicly and clearly opposed disreputable leaders, officials who have amassed disproportionate wealth, and those involved in property grabbing. They must actively oppose harmful ideologies and individuals. Mere superficial opposition (“A wolf in sheep's clothing”) shall not be accepted.
 - F. **Awareness of Social Issues:** Candidates must demonstrate readiness to identify and combat social evils, for example:
 - i. They must name at least five individuals involved in female feticide or those who misuse anti-male laws to harass in-laws and must demonstrate a clear commitment to fighting such practices.
 - ii. **Simplicity and Environmental Responsibility:** Candidates must reject ostentatious wedding ceremonies and similar extravagance.
 - iii. To prevent environmental harm, candidates must support reducing the use of banners and must have donated the money thus saved to the needy on at least three occasions. They must show commitment to leading campaigns that discourage future generations from wasteful public displays.
- 2. **Residence & Service given:-** Any individual seeking candidacy in a particular constituency must have resided within a 40 to 45 kilometre radius of that constituency for at least five years and must have demonstrated active efforts in public service in that area. **Government employment shall not be considered qualifying criteria.**
 - A. If a person has carried out significant work that has benefited lakhs of people in the constituency while working at state-level/regional private organisations, their name may be directly included in the Divine Lottery process.
 - B. **Priority** shall be given to taxpayers who have never committed any crime and have actively worked for the welfare of the people. After completing the financial process, such individuals may directly participate in the Divine Lottery.
 - i. Even in such cases, the individual must have completed their schooling and HSC college education in constituency, must have resided there for at least one year before seeking candidature, must have meaningful local connections, and their family must have demonstrated active/ethical social participation in the area.
 - ii. If family members have not done social work then the person should reside in constituency for more than three years.

C. Commitment to Social Service – Rules for Movements and Charity

The candidate's involvement in social, industrial, or spiritual movements must be genuine and undisputed. Government jobs and constitutional positions exist to serve the public. Those who seek additional power while already in such roles are not serving the people — they are merely enjoying the fruits of power. Keeping all positions within one's own family is not only immoral but also unconstitutional.

- i. **“To have your cake and eat it too” Rule:** No new opportunities shall be given to government employees or any of their close relatives. They must contribute to social change through their existing government service. This rule is inspired by SEBI regulations that prohibit CMDs and MDs from having relatives in certain positions. The National Committee shall define which family relationships are covered under this rule in its first meeting.
 1. Individuals who have resigned from government service may become eligible for candidacy starting from the fifth year after their resignation. Their family members may also be considered after this period.
3. **Public Debate :-** Candidates who qualify on the above points shall participate in public debates and discussions. Their relative merit shall be determined through these debates.
- A. **After winning an election, appointments and responsibilities shall be assigned according to this merit ranking.**
 - B. The names of the top ten to twenty candidates (or such number as the Central Committee may decide depending on the election) shall be entered into the Divine Lottery / lottery process.
4. **Financials :-** Candidates who wish their names to be included in the Divine Lottery process must first deposit the prescribed ticket fee (“bhishi/patti”) into the Party's election account and an equal/decided amount into the Party's main account. **The dream that “one can become an MLA for ten lakh rupees, an MP for twenty lakh rupees, and that reserved category citizens will gain rightful decision-making power after every victory” will become reality through this Party.** Ordinary citizens will have a genuine opportunity to attain high positions and rights. This will mark the beginning of the immediate realization of the words “social/political justice & equality” contained in the Preamble of the Constitution.
- A. Currently, becoming an MLA or MP costs individuals crores of rupees. Party's revolutionary approach brings that figure down to just a few lakhs per person.
 - B.** Before the Divine Lottery is conducted, all candidates' ticket-fee contributions must be deposited into the election & party account. **When the AB Form is issued to the selected candidate, the corresponding ticket-fee amount shall be transferred to that candidate's account.**
 - C. When the combined ticket fees from all candidates and alternate candidates reach lakhs or crores, **the Party's candidates (and alternate candidates) will be able to win elections easily — backed by the strength of Party unity,**

powerful manifesto ideas capable of immediately solving national problems, and modest financial resources.



5. **Donating Half & explaining wealth accumulation :-** The Party shall not offer any position to close relatives of individuals who have accepted foreign citizenship. **This restriction shall not apply to** those who voluntarily deposit half of their personal assets into the Party's main account every five years. While no one can guarantee the future actions of relatives, this method of donating half of one's assets every five years is accepted as credible proof of genuine intent to enter politics solely for the public good.
 - A. If the Party identifies any unique or urgent matters in its permanent Manifesto, such principles shall also be applied to candidate selection.
 - B. **ITR of Every candidate:** They must submit a complete and detailed declaration of their own assets and the assets of all immediate family members before nomination. This declaration must include all properties held in the name of close family members. For those seeking higher positions, it shall be mandatory to submit Income Tax Returns (ITR) of their parents, all children, and in-laws for the previous five years. Candidates must explain in 1000-words how they earned the wealth.
 - C. The responsibility of reviewing all such declarations shall rest with the Discipline Committee.
6. **Requirement of Resignation (before going for New Positions):** In situations where a person wishes to move from a State Legislative Assembly to Parliament (or similar upward movement), any sitting MLA or public representative must first have their resignation from the current position formally accepted through proper procedure before contesting for the next position. This ensures that no candidate holds multiple positions simultaneously.

B. Criteria for Excluding Harmful Individuals from High Positions

People who pretend to serve the public while actually enjoying personal benefits are harmful to society. The Party shall strictly uphold the following two principles:

1) Opportunities for Existing Public Representatives:

- A. Sitting MLAs or MPs from other parties who wish to join this Party and seek its ticket must first donate half of their family's total wealth (including all assets held in the names of family members) for the welfare of their constituency. Only then shall they be given an opportunity in this Party. **This will ensure alignment with the Party's values of unity and honesty without doing injustice to long-**

standing loyal Party foot-soldiers. Such donations shall be credited to the Party's Third bank account "Donation Account."

- a. If such representatives from other parties wish their names to be directly included in the Divine Lottery, they must leave their previous party at least six months before the election is announced. If they fulfil all conditions set by the Prosperity Committee, participate in debates, meet the financial criteria, their name may be directly entered into the lottery for the election occurring in the sixth month.
- b. The Party, when in government, shall enact a law limiting every elected member in each house to only two terms (ten years). Those who participate in the Party's selfless Divine Lottery process will eventually get an opportunity to hold office, and **their social service efforts will never go to waste**. Their names, along with their families, shall remain permanently on the list for alternate MLA/MP positions & they can rule for even fifty terms as alternate candidates..!!
- c. This unique system of the Party will begin to permanently end social divisions, casteism, and the practice of pulling down good people who enter politics. **It will foster true social harmony. Every community will have individuals participating through the lottery process, and the culture of undermining good people or dragging each other down in politics will end forever.**

Because of this, the Party expects an unprecedented response from capable individuals who are tired of dynastic politics in other parties, from those fed up with corrupt practices, and from people who have been cheated after paying money for tickets in current conventional parties.

2) Restrictions on Personal Assistants:

- a. Personal assistants to Ministers, Ministers of State, or equivalent high-ranking officials, as well as state-level and divisional Party presidents, shall be permanently ineligible to contest elections or have their names included in the Party's candidate lottery. This is to ensure they remain fully focused on their administrative duties. Their role must stay dedicated solely to promoting and implementing the Party's ideology.
- b. However, a small number of these exceptionally dedicated workers may be considered for the ten reserved slots in the Divine Lottery process for direct ministerial selection.

3) Restrictions on Certain Professionals and Public Figures

1) Ineligibility: The following categories of individuals shall be ineligible to contest elections under the Party's banner:

- Any person currently holding a government job
- Gynaecologists/obstetricians and their staff

- Major industrialists (for example, individuals like Vijay Mallya)
 - Popular Actors, athletes, artists and sports persons
- a. **Rationale for government officials:** Public servants already have opportunities to serve the nation. It is not expected that they should pursue political office out of personal ambition. Such ambition while serving on govt job creates a conflict of interest.
 - b. **Rationale for gynaecologists:** In a past incident in Parbhani, a patient suffered neglect and loss of life due to a gynaecologist's political involvement. Therefore, such professionals and their staff are barred from time-consuming political roles.
 - c. **Rationale for industrialists:** Individuals who have built wealth through government contracts or bank loans did so using public resources; hence they shall be prohibited from holding political office to prevent greed and misuse of connections/power. Those who flaunt luxury which in reality is funded by public money will have no place in this Party.
 - d. **Rationale for athletes and artists:** These individuals already have access to public positions through Presidential or gubernatorial nominations. They should not compete for Party tickets, so that dedicated Party workers can have fair opportunities.

Emphasis on Professional Commitment:

Candidates must prioritize their chosen field of work rather than using politics for personal gain. Because strengthening social harmony, dedication, and impartiality is essential, individuals who indulge in speaking with a forked tongue shall be excluded from the Party.

Article VI:

The Party's Permanent Manifesto

The party is unwavering in its commitment to policies that deliver genuine prosperity for the people. Indians have grown weary of leaders who deliver **nothing but fiery speeches**, only to watch those same figures drag the nation into ruin because their parties lack any binding ideological compass.

- a. When the BJP was convicted by the High Court in 2015 for receiving illegal foreign donations in flagrant violation of the FCRA, every political party responded in the most predictable way: they rushed through retrospective amendments that rendered the court's verdict toothless. **This episode lays bare a bitter truth — all major parties function like cartels, protecting their own interests and those of their corporate backers rather than serving the citizenry.**
- b. Once our party secures a majority government, it will channel the same determination and resourcefulness - **but this time exclusively in** the service of ordinary citizens. In the first full seven years, decisive and uncompromising action will be taken on every critical issue. **If party is not doing so, Party can be closed down after such meaningful accusation and by following the given procedure in Article III.D.6/7.**

Learning from such many incidents/ethical failures, the party's constitution enshrines a set of transformative **structures and policies** designed to overhaul the country. The pledge "If you elect us, we will do what no other party has ever done" is not empty rhetoric; **every commitment is locked into the constitution itself, making it binding and non-negotiable.**

Until we form a majority government, every one of our Party's elected representative — whether in opposition or in power — will vote strictly in accordance with the manifesto and work at full throttle to turn its promises into reality. Any representative found shirking this duty will face swift removal from the party as per **Article III.D.6/7.**

If the public truly wants a credible alternative, concerned citizens must join the party, or at least help it capture both state and central governments, and enable radical change to begin from the very first month. Almost every decision and law outlined below is designed for immediate enactment within the first month. The party is fully committed to committed timelines. **Should it fail to deliver even after receiving a clear mandate, the constitution itself provides mechanisms for the public to dissolve the party. This is our word....!!**

Subject-specific committees, working together with the party's founders, will hold weekly one-hour online discussions with anyone raising objections/suggestions. FULL DETAILS

The decisions and laws our government will enact within the stipulated timelines are as follows:

1) Taxation of All Political Parties

A law will be introduced on the very first day requiring every political party to pay up to 10% tax. While this is projected to generate approximately ₹5,000 crore annually, the real significance lies in enforcing constitutional equality before the law — something far more important than any revenue figure.

2) Reforming the Election Commission

Supreme Court Judge BV Nagaratna quoted on Election Commission : “If those who conduct elections are dependent on those who contest them, the neutrality of the process cannot be assured.” To ensure the Election Commission functions with complete accuracy and impartiality, a dedicated recruitment process for EC will be conducted and all necessary legal changes will be introduced. The required investment will be made within the first week to transform Election Commission into a truly robust, independent institution.

3) Protection of Citizens and Right to Protest

A law will be passed in the first week guaranteeing that the government may seek army assistance for maintaining public order during protests but it can never prevent any citizen from registering a peaceful protest. House arrests and similar restrictions will be abolished within the first month.

Discipline control teams will maintain order at protest sites, but no government effort will be allowed to curtail the constitutional right to peaceful demonstration.

Govt will have rights limited solely to prevent violence at protest sites; and in a truly autonomous India, safeguarding freedom of expression will remain the government’s foremost priority.

Those groups/parties blocking roads or cities due to protests will be banned. Everyone, including ministers, on the street blocking citizen’s daily life will be put in jail for 3 years, without any bail provisions. Historic organic protests of over one lakhs or more agitators are excluded from jail, under citizens fundamental democratic right to protest, and citizens of that city will have to bear with such agitations done organically and city-dwellers should appreciate the rights of people to protest. If any particular group is found funding such huge protests as attention-grabbing technique then every member of that group will be jailed for three years of rigorous punishment.

4) Reform in Sports Administration

Selection of athletes representing the nation will be entrusted exclusively to tax-paying sports organisations & government-controlled bodies run by former players.

- i) Any organisation wishing to remain fully tax-exempt must fund all its infrastructure, stadiums, training facilities, and broadcasts independently; it will be barred from using public resources or facilities funded by public in any means.
- ii) It will be made a criminal offence for any political figure or their close relatives to head such organisations, unless they show high-level proficiency in the same sport they wish to monitor. This transparent system will be operational by the end of the first month, paving the way for Indian athletes to begin winning Olympic medals as their care-taking organization will play no politics in national sports teams selection.

5) Boosting Industry and Investment

- (a) **The government is not a real-estate broker.** The existing rule forcing citizens to reinvest property-sale proceeds within three years to save tax will be scrapped in the first month, freeing capital for investment across every sector and spurring broad-based industrial growth.
- (i) Citizens will receive full tax relief when sale proceeds are invested in any legitimate avenue, **finally removing the stain of the government acting as a de-facto property dealer.**
- (b) Government doesn't have any religion hence Temple management will be freed from State control or no religious establishment will be free from Govt control. Either this or that.
- (c) **Compassionate Conservative Shivajirao Nade Act** - Forcing people to invest in other markets by reducing FD rates is downright cartel-type move by government. Hence, for every step of the way in economy a choice of investment rates, models will be given to citizens. This way seniors can opt for high rate FD's or some may choose high-risk aggressive equity market tools. Let the population decide and not have government dictate what to do. It's government not a parent.. 😊
- (d) Modular homes on the Boxable model (or similar) will be provided to the homeless, backed by legislation in the first month, this is done so as to enable their full contribution to national progress by making them happy/stress-free.

6) Revenue Generation through Vanity Number Plates

- b. All constitutional changes made during the **Emergency** will be repealed in the first month.

- a) Cabinet ministers will be restricted to a single five-year term; there will be no limit for ministers of state.
 1. Mr Ajit Pawar was addiction-free person & he was man of his word. - c) **A valid caste certificate** will be mandatory for contesting reserved seats, ending decades of deception via fake certificate claims, that waste public money and time on re-elections.
 - d) **No single village or community** will be allowed to dominate both houses of Parliament. A Father being CM/minister and couple of children/nephews as MP/MLA's will be maximum limit for a family to participate in electoral politics. "Anyone trying to play smart by changing addresses of family members, to get more members of a family in MLA/MP positions at the same time will have all members of family disqualified, from even current positions."
- Such law will be made.

- b) Fair compensation and rehabilitation will be guaranteed for land acquired for projects such as the Shaktipeeth Expressway. Unused/unutilised project land will be returned to original owners after 40–50 years; those who mislead about such project success will face lifetime hard labour as punishment and their asset seizures for paying victim compensation, applied retrospectively.
- c) Water sources will be rejuvenated and a national water grid modelled on the Marathwada grid will be built in every state.
- d) Effective control measures will be introduced against destructive wildlife, to protect crops and farmers'/villagers' livelihoods.

10) Social Discipline Control Teams

Dedicated teams of 25–50 courageous youths (robotic units where feasible) will patrol every ward day and night to curb public indecency and local goonism. Investment will begin in the first month, with rotation of youths in city areas, to prevent “familiarity breeding misconduct” by youth themselves.

- a) In peacetime, these teams will manage traffic, maintain/enforce cleanliness, and assist senior citizens.
- b) In sensitive areas showing signs of unrest, all utilities may be temporarily suspended, encouraging citizens to assist in handing anti-social elements of area over to authorities.

11) Contempt of Citizen Act - Expansion of Atrocity Laws

Drawing on the constitutional ideals of equality and fraternity, the Atrocity Act will be extended to cover every citizen. Any proven public insult backed by clear video, audio, or media evidence will be a non-bailable offence. The offender will pay ₹5 lakh immediate compensation to the victim, undergo one month of counselling, and serve one month of hard labour if insult/swear word has sexual connotations. Punishment will double with each repeat offence.

A clear list of what constitutes an insult will be published before enforcement of this law in the first month (**examples include** cattiest slurs, derogatory references to poverty or appearance, sudden verbal abuse, or abuse of official position for hurling insults).

12) Department of Garbage Elimination (DOGE India)

A dedicated national department will be created to eliminate waste, with people passionate in this area of work getting appointed to leadership roles of DOGE India mission. Opposing the mission or continuing to litter will attract jail term of ten years of hard labour.

If results remain absent despite massive spending - as seen in the Smart Cities Mission, the assets of all officials involved will be seized. **The Modi government spent ₹4 lakh crore over twelve years of Swatccha Bharat Abhiyaan, with no visible improvement; such failures will no longer be tolerated.**

This will be done retrospectively for every Abhiyaan since independence. The only way to avoid jail term of deceased officers or their surviving heir will be by donating half of wealth of each family member to the poor of their own community (on education, health, skills trainings etc).

Public posts like following will be treated as lapses of govt workers. Action against such govt staff will be initiated based on such posts.

13) Road Safety and Infrastructure

- a) All 4,000 MLAs, 788 MPs, ministers, 30 lakh government employees, and 25,000 judges will be required by law to use public transport. All official vehicles will be sold and the proceeds reinvested in upgrading public systems with preference to Rapid Railway Transit in cities.
- b) A one-time annual toll payment for removing all toll plazas, proposed by the All India Motor Transport Congress will make national highways toll-free, reducing transport costs, freight rates, and accidents. This proposal will be implemented.

- d) Heavy vehicles will be banned from the first lane of six-lane highways to prevent tragedies like those involving Vinayakrao Mete and Cyrus Mistry.

14. Article 371 – Comprehensive Regional Development

- e) The losing party in any lawsuit will bear all costs, deterring frivolous litigation. Such law will be brought in country.
- f) **Wrongful arrests that destroy years of a person's life** (as seen in the cases of Muhammad Ali, Nambi Narayanan, and Sonam Wangchuk) will be treated under MCOCA-like laws, with full compensation paid from the wrongdoers' assets sale.
- g) **In essence, People's Judiciary Act will be made – Breaking the Dynasty Cartel and Ensuring Swift, Fair Access to Justice "We, the Party, commit to overhauling India's higher judiciary to end the systemic hijacking of the Supreme Court by a tiny elite of dynastic lawyers and judges.**

The current structure – capped at just 34 judges, operating barely 200 days a year for 4.5 hours daily, with 95% of Special Leave Petitions (SLPs) and writs dismissed in under 93 seconds on “Miscellaneous Days” – **has turned the apex court into an exclusive club inaccessible to ordinary citizens, first-generation lawyers, MSMEs, undertrials, and victims of grave injustice such as death-row appeals pending for decades.**

3. **Dismantle the dynastic cartel:** Introduce a transparent, merit-based “Roster and Appearance Code” that caps the number of appearances by any single lawyer or law firm in admission-stage matters in any given month. **Publish real-time data** on lawyer appearances, success rates, and fees in PILs and high-value cases. Reserve a minimum 30 to 50% of admission-stage slots exclusively for first-generation lawyers and those representing common litigants, slum dwellers, and MSMEs.
4. **Regulate and curb PIL abuse:** Restrict PILs strictly to genuine, justiciable public-interest issues. Require petitioners and lawyers to disclose funding sources and political affiliations. Empower the Attorney General (as *parens patriae*) as the sole gatekeeper for public-interest matters, with mandatory penalties for frivolous or politically motivated PILs filed for fame, money, or to bypass Parliament.
5. **Enhance accountability and transparency:** **Make all Court proceedings (except in-camera matters) live-streamed** with timestamps. Introduce annual performance audits of judge productivity and case disposal rates. Ensure judges and senior lawyers declare conflicts of interest publicly.

This is not incremental reform – this is a decisive strike against the entrenched vested interests that have converted the Supreme Court into a tool of the elite. By implementing these measures within the first 100 days of Party government, we will restore the Supreme Court to “We the People,” deliver justice in months/years instead of decades, protect democracy from judicial overreach, and open the doors of the judiciary to every Indian, not just the dynasties.

Justice delayed is justice denied. Under our Party government, justice will no longer be sold to the highest bidder.

16) **Judicial Accountability**

 - d) All people connected with government or employees of publicly funded institutions will be required to use the government funded facilities for their own children.  - e) The existing practice of awarding ₹1 crore to a government employee's family and only ₹5 lakh to an ordinary citizen killed on the road will be abolished. Every life is equally precious; deaths caused by government's project negligence will be compensated at ₹1 crore per victim, **recovered from the assets of responsible officials and ministers of the preceding decade.**

(i) Natural Sugar & Allied Industries, Latur Maharashtra leader Mr. B. B. Thombare has a success story about this since 2004 year and it's high time we make this nationwide law. This case study saw strengthening of family bonds, reducing pension burdens, and ensuring long-term economic security.

i) A lifelong 2% honorariums from a disciple's annual income will be paid to gurus, applied retrospectively from Independence Day, to foster genuine guru-shishya loyalty.

j) Dedicated cells will support love marriages among educated, addiction-free youth, reducing social stigma and promoting national well-being.

18) **Public Health**

Nationwide Ban on Alcohol and Tobacco Inspired by Sumitra Pednekar's courageous fight following her husband's death from tobacco-related cancer, the government will impose a complete nationwide ban on the production and sale of alcohol and tobacco, closing all manufacturing units. Partial bans have only increased costs and social harm; a genuine, comprehensive prohibition will eliminate addiction, reduce economic burdens, and promote healthier communities. **If any intoxicating substances remain permitted, farmers will receive cultivation rights so that honest cultivators are not penalised while other corporate honchos profit.**

19) **Doubling of Jobs concept, for Youth and Family Prosperity**

20) Investment in Critical Sectors

Global Data and Economic Impact: Countries like Singapore, Hong Kong, and Switzerland have zero capital gains tax. Between 1990 and 1997, their per capita real income grew at twice the rate (2.2%) of OECD countries. Securities Transaction Tax reduces trading volume by 20–60% and can lower GDP by up to 1.76%. Sweden abolished this tax in 1991, resulting in an immediate surge in trading volume and efficiency. In India, this will reduce the cost of equity capital, boost corporate investment, and support GDP growth.

B. Increasing Equity Exposure in Pension and Retirement Funds

Manifesto Commitment: Increase equity allocation in the National Pension System (NPS) and Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) to 75–100% and provide additional tax deductions for equity-linked savings products.

Expected Impact in India: Ensure stable long-term domestic capital, reduce dependence on foreign flows, and enhance market stability.

Global Data and Economic Impact: In the United States, over \$13 trillion is invested in equities through 401(k) and IRA plans — nearly one-fourth of household wealth — creating a significant “wealth effect”. In India, this will reduce market volatility, boost consumption and investment, and drive GDP growth.

C. Liberalizing Foreign Investment Norms

Manifesto Commitment: Permit 100% FDI through the automatic route in priority sectors such as manufacturing, defence, and banking; simplify FPI registration, unified KYC, and compliance procedures.

Expected Impact in India: Accelerate technology transfer, industrial modernization, and infrastructure development.

Global Data and Economic Impact: Stock market liberalization in emerging economies has increased share prices by 15.1% and reduced risk. A 1% increase in FDI-to-GDP ratio boosts GDP by 0.4%. In Vietnam and Indonesia, liberalization doubled FDI inflows, leading to higher employment and productivity. In India, this could raise annual GDP growth by 0.5–1%.

D. Corporate Governance, Investor Protection, and Regulatory Simplification

Manifesto Commitment: Make ESG disclosures mandatory, implement real-time grievance redressal through the SEBI platform, and introduce a unified compliance framework based on company size.

Expected Impact in India: Increase retail investor confidence, reduce corporate risk, and make capital raising easier for MSMEs.

Global Data and Economic Impact: Countries with strong investor protection (e.g., USA, Singapore) have larger and more liquid markets. Governance reforms reduce the risk of market crashes by 13%. Digital compliance in Singapore and Estonia has cut business costs by 30–50% and increased IPOs.

E. Capital Raising and Modernization of Market Infrastructure

Manifesto Commitment: Simplify IPO norms and disclosure requirements for SMEs and startups, promote new listings, and integrate fintech with the settlement cycle.

Expected Impact in India: Enable MSMEs to access equity funding instead of debt, foster innovation, and generate employment.

Global Data and Economic Impact: After the US JOBS Act (2012), IPOs by small companies increased by 25%. Global stock exchange studies show that market development leads to higher GDP growth in emerging economies.

Overall, Vision and National Impact

These commitments will raise India's market capitalization-to-GDP ratio (currently 115–140%) to the level of developed countries (200%+). According to global studies, deepening of financial markets can increase annual GDP growth by 0.4–1% or more.

If implemented with regulatory autonomy and in a phased manner, these reforms will create wealth for millions of households, realize the vision of 'Developed India' and position India as the top preferred destination for global investors.

- (1) **Any proposal, which is popular among economists, will be taken up for discussion in the first month and a law will be enacted on it.** Experts are of the opinion that Income Tax should be abolished and there should be only one tax — GST — on Indian citizens. About cess's & divisible pool, here will be guiding thoughts of Party Govt.

1. Even if all revenue entered the divisible pool, the FC would still allocate by formula, not by collection origin.

What should be done instead? Practical, targeted reforms (many already suggested by experts, past FCs, and state demands):

- **Cap + transparency:** Legally cap cess + surcharge at 10–12% of GTR (or whatever prudent level). Any excess automatically flows into the divisible pool. Every cess must have a sunset clause, separate account, and annual CAG-audited utilisation report published publicly. Unspent balances should lapse back to the pool.
- **Stronger ring-fencing for true cesses:** Surcharges can stay general-purpose, but cesses must be strictly purpose-specific and not used as disguised general revenue.
- **Finance Commission tweaks (for the next one):** Give slightly more weight to “tax effort” and fiscal discipline metrics. Consider effective (not just nominal) devolution when setting the vertical share. Some states already push for this.
- **Broader fiscal autonomy for states:** Give states more own-revenue tools (e.g., refine GST compensation, allow limited piggy-back taxes). Reduce vertical dependence overall. Encourage competitive federalism—states that perform better (higher GSDP growth, better tax buoyancy, lower fiscal deficit) should visibly gain.
- **Accountability both ways:** Centre must stop treating cess as a perpetual loophole. States must stop under-utilising funds or blaming the Centre for their own governance gaps.

Our intuition about rewarding contributing states and discouraging free-riding is economically sound — incentives matter. The current setup creates some moral hazard. But the solution is smarter design and transparency, not abolition or a shift to pure origin-based taxation. India is one economic union; some redistribution is inevitable and desirable for stability. **The goal should be cooperative federalism that rewards performance while maintaining equity — not a zero-sum fight.**

This debate is healthy. States (especially high-performers) are right to push back; the Centre is right that absolute resources have grown. Better rules, not bans, fix the imbalance.

23) Economic Growth through Industry and Tourism

- a) Stock-market trading hours will be extended from 9 am to 9 pm with live visibility, giving every investor equal access. FII, DII's and HNI's will have same trading hours as common public.
- b) Industry and tourism policies will be finalised through expert committee consultations.

24) **Preservation of National Heritage**

Public holidays will be aligned with major Indian festivals for two months annually, preserving cultural traditions.

A structured naming policy will honour local, regional, and national contributors at every administrative level, replacing all previous nationwide project names.

25) **Electoral and Administrative Reforms**

- a) Paper ballots will replace EVMs to restore verifiable secrecy and public trust.
- b) Preferential voting will be introduced nationwide.
- c) A citizen-rating system similar to ride-hailing apps will determine appointments and awards, rewarding consistent ethical conduct.

Detailed thought forming basis of outlined reforms –

a) Paper Ballots:

The party's government will support paper ballots instead of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs). Paper ballots are widely accepted even in advanced democracies and have become very necessary to remove doubts regarding the integrity of elections.

The biggest advantage of paper ballots is that voting remains secret and no one can put pressure on the voter to give a lead in the village. It becomes easy to win over people's minds. Often, if votes are known booth-wise, then secret voting loses all meaning.

i) An excellent cricket player is ready to play on any type of ball; **the player who demands only one type of ball is clearly up to some mischief.** If major benefit of EVMs is touted as being able to declare results immediately and if, even after the results, the Chief Minister (2019, 2024) or Mayor (2026) is not decided for months by the current parties or the alliance's, **then why this hurry for the results using EVM's??**

ii) Till 2023, only 19% of countries (34 out of 178) use e-voting at the national or sub-national level, **while 6% (11 countries) have abandoned e-voting due to concerns over trust and security.**

(1) Notable examples: The **Netherlands** banned e-voting in 2007 after a demonstration of hacking vulnerability and returned to paper ballots. **Germany** also returned to paper ballots due to concerns over reliability and transparency. In the **United States**, during the 2020 election, 93% of votes had a paper record; only 0.5% of constituencies used EVMs without a voter-verified paper audit trail (VVPAT). This shows a global trend towards paper systems for increased security.

(2) Views of prominent personalities: Personalities **like Elon Musk and Tulsi Gabbard** have raised questions about the reliability of EVMs and mentioned the risks of cyber interference and lack of auditability. In

India, the continuous controversies regarding EVMs (e.g., the 2019 Delhi Assembly incident where AAI MLA proved ability of rigging the machines) reduce public trust.

Although the paper ballot system requires a time-consuming five-day or more counting process, it ensures verified and undisputed results and strengthens democratic trust. **Countries like Canada, Finland, and the United Kingdom** rely only on manually counted paper ballots for national elections and give priority to transparency over speed.

iii) **Final Solution:** If EVMs have to be used at all, then the party government's first law will be: "EVM results will be temporary and the final results will be declared only after the actual counting of every VVPAT."

b) **Preferential Voting System:** To avoid vote division that harms deserving candidates, the party's government will enact a law in the first month to use the **preferential voting system** — which is used in teachers' and graduates' constituencies — in every election. This will ensure fair representation of the people's choice.

i) **This system, similar to the Single Transferable Vote used in Australia and Ireland, allows voters to rank candidates in order of preference, reduces wasted votes, and ensures wider representation.**

c) **Citizen Rating System for Appointments and Awards:** The party government will implement a citizen feedback system similar to the simple rating apps used for rating of taxi drivers. Govt Appointments and awards will be decided on the basis of this system. This system will reward consistent good conduct, strengthen the idea that daily positive actions bring concrete honour, **and increase the number of well-behaved citizens.** **As a result, public trust in a united nation and administrative integrity will rise.**

26) Rural Empowerment and Community Development

- a) Every government employee will be required to resolve problems in their native village, taking Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan to the next level, with emphasis on selfless duty.
- b) World-class recreational and sports facilities will be built in every taluka to check urban migration.
- c) AC or heated halls will be built in all villages so as to make lives of aging population easy during extreme seasons.
- d) **Village washing machines, dishwashers, and community kitchens will reduce women's domestic burden.**
 - (i) Community Kitchens :- Nutritional meal programmes and rotational cooking by women in every village will ensure healthy children &

families. This will also free women's time for family and small enterprises when they aren't cooking for the village/colony.

- e) Divorce and alimony laws will be reformed for swift six-month no-fault resolution, equal asset division, and protection of children's best interests.
 1. **Kentucky's divorce rate fell** roughly 25% from 2016 to 2023 after a 2018 law made 50/50 shared custody the default. When custody is more predictable and fair, it cuts down on fights and removes the money motive for battling over kids. This means fewer court wars and more choices based on what's stable for the family, not just leverage.
 - a. Kentucky House Bill 528 (2018), signed by Gov. Matt Bevin on April 26, 2018 and effective July 14, 2018, was the first U.S. state law to create a rebuttable presumption of equal (50/50) shared parenting time and joint decision-making as being in the child's best interest (absent abuse, neglect, or other disqualifying factors). It amended KRS 403.270 and related statutes.

Details of Rural Empowerment and Community Development concepts:

a) Gram Sakshamikaran Abhiyaan :

Taking inspiration from the teachings of Legends about sacrifice, charity, and discipline, and from the model of educational institutions adopting villages under the Ujjwal Bharat Abhiyan, the party will launch the Gram Sakshamikaran Abhiyaan. It will be mandatory for government employees to resolve community problems in their place of residence and native villages. This will promote social responsibility and ensure that their salaries are not misused for selfish practices like platform usury/or conventional lending practices.

b) Urban Migration Control and Recreation Centres:

To prevent migration to cities, the party will develop cultural recreation centres in every taluka, including swimming pools, theatres, sports complexes, and libraries. District sports complexes will be upgraded to global standards. Expert coaches will be provided to train players, which will promote local opportunities and youth development.

AC/Heated halls will be built in every village for comfort in extreme seasons, for ageing population in villages.

c) Health and Recreation Facilities:

Facilities such as jogging tracks and oxygen parks will be established in large villages, which will improve public health.

d) Environmental Sustainability: Ban on Excessive Banner Use

To prevent urban defacement and environmental damage caused by plastic banners, the party will implement laws to minimise the use of banners. The funds thus saved will be asked to be redirected to help the needy. This will particularly curb unnecessary popularity displays by party leaders (even when their electoral

success is in doldrums) and address environmental concerns arising from the practices of other parties.

e) Pollution-Free Communities:

The party will undertake initiatives to make villages and towns in every Lok Sabha constituency dust-free and pollution-free, giving priority to health.

f) Women's self-respect & Welfare:

i) Household Infrastructure:

The party government will implement schemes in the first month to provide washing machines and dishwashers in villages. These will include water recycling systems, which will reduce the domestic burden on women.

ii) Nutritious Meal Programme:

A rotational system will be established in villages whereby women will prepare nutritious breakfast and lunch for school-going children. This will promote community participation and ensure healthy children. The villagers will bear the cost through collective contribution. If necessary, the government will send funds or personnel to every village to make the scheme successful and build a healthy generation.

During Covid such assistance was given to many villages, why not do this voluntarily for the common good.

(1) Community Kitchen Initiative:

To increase unity in the village and reduce domestic disputes arising from kitchen responsibilities, the party government will implement a daily meal preparation programme in community kitchens funded through collective contributions. This will ensure that underprivileged children receive nutritious food every day. The rotational system for cooking responsibilities will free up women's time for their families and small-scale industries when it's not their turn to cook for the village.

iii) Removing Inequality in Alimony:

Demanding dowry is illegal, yet paying alimony in the divorce process is mandatory. **Many women consider this an insult to their dignity.** Understanding this, the party government will carry out legal reforms to end this inequality, promote gender equality, and uphold constitutional fairness. It will completely curb the tendency of one spouse to seize the other's property by getting divorces and will enact laws that are in keeping with India's thousands of years of culture.

A new law containing all the provisions discussed below will be enacted. Some steps were taken in this regard in 2013, but no further action was taken. Therefore, this law will be made within the first two weeks by our Party Government.

We will do things like what China did..

Background and Context

China's divorce rate rose sharply in recent decades, prompting policymakers to prioritize "family-friendly" measures. The reforms shift away from earlier rules that treated most assets acquired during marriage as community property subject to equal division. They emphasize personal responsibility, documentation, and financial independence.

These changes have sparked global debate:

- Supporters see them as fairer, reducing "gold-digging" incentives and litigation.
- Critics argue they disadvantage non-working spouses (often women) who contributed through unpaid labor.

The rules apply nationwide and cover both registered marriages and (in some interpretations) certain cohabitation scenarios.

Note: This is based on the official SPC interpretation and consistent reporting from legal analyses. Individual cases still depend on evidence presented in court, and couples are advised to use prenuptial agreements for clarity. For the most authoritative text, refer to the Supreme People's Court documents (in Chinese).

China's 2025 Divorce Law Reform refers to key updates introduced through a Supreme People's Court (SPC) judicial interpretation on the Marriage and Family Section of the Civil Code (Interpretation II), effective February 1, 2025 (some sources note February 2).

These changes do not create an entirely new "divorce law" but refine how the existing Civil Code applies to property division, spousal support, and related matters. The reforms aim to reduce impulsive divorces, curb litigation, promote family stability, and emphasize financial contributions over automatic equal splits amid high divorce rates in China.

1. Property Division: "Who Pays, Owns" / Title-Based Rule

This is the most significant and controversial shift.

- **No more automatic 50/50 splits:** Marital property is no longer presumed to be equally divided. Courts now prioritize financial contributions, title registration, and proof of direct payments or investments.

- **Title and pre-marital assets win:** Property (homes, vehicles, investments, businesses) registered in one spouse's name stays with that spouse unless the other proves direct financial or labor contribution (e.g., bank transfers, contracts, or receipts). Pre-marital property remains fully with the original owner.

- **Non-financial contributions ignored:** Homemaking, childcare, or other unpaid labor no longer factors into property division.

- **Parental contributions protected:** Assets funded by one spouse's parents (common for housing) are treated as that spouse's property.

- **Even joint names don't guarantee division:** If one spouse funded it, they retain ownership unless proven otherwise.

Example:

A house bought by a husband before marriage (or with his funds) remains his, even if the wife's name was later added.

2. Alimony / Spousal Maintenance

- **Essentially eliminated in most cases:** There is no automatic right to alimony (spousal support) after divorce.

- **Requires prior agreement:** Payments only occur if the couple had a pre-existing financial agreement (similar to a prenup). Courts do not generally order ongoing support.

- **Limited exceptions:** Rare cases involving extreme hardship (e.g., one spouse sacrificed career for child-rearing) may still see limited support, but this is not the default.

3. Mandatory 30-Day Cooling-Off Period

- Applies to mutual (uncontested) divorces registered at civil affairs offices.

- Either party can withdraw the application during this period, halting the divorce.

- Goal: Discourage rash decisions (this builds on a similar rule introduced in 2021 but reinforced in the 2025 interpretation).

4. Child Custody and Parenting

- Joint custody promoted by default: Courts are encouraged to award shared parenting unless one parent is clearly unfit.
- Focus on children's best interests and both parents' ongoing responsibilities.

This post presents the difficulties and the Delhi High Court's decision. Based on this, changes to the following laws will be made in the first month. In 2013, Kapil Sibal had demanded that a law should be made to grant divorce in the first year. This will now be implemented.

Supreme Court judgment in Chaturbhuj v. Sita Bai (2008) clarified that maintenance laws are preventive, not punitive. Their main purpose is to ensure that someone who cannot maintain themselves does not fall into poverty or neglect. The Madras High Court also mentioned the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, which gives senior citizens a legal right to be supported by their children.

In essence, our Party's govt will frame following law -

- (1) If one spouse demands divorce, it will be granted immediately in the sixth month (No-Fault Divorce). In the intervening period, only discussions regarding counselling, guidance, and future planning for the children will be held. The practice of taking several decades to grant a divorce — which is foolish and exploitative of couples, enriching lawyers — will be changed immediately.
- (2) If, after marriage, an attempt is seen to separate the husband from his parents, and yet the husband has progressed, then no part of that progress will be given to the wife at the time of divorce.
 - a. If a housewife is speaking with her side of family every day, spending insane amounts of time on social media daily then she will be held responsible for breaking the marriage. If a girl who starts new job tells her own family “Don't call me, I am busy at my new job, I have to prove myself here, so need to invest huge amounts of time at new company..” then why can't she do the same after getting married? **Nothing wrong to expect her to tell** her side to leave her alone so that she can focus on building many new relationships enabled due to her marriage.
 - b. Historically, a girl used to visit maternal home only during 2 vacations a year, never on any other times. She used to have no contact with her parents when at her matrimonial home. These days girls are more focused on meeting their side of family only, without investing time to get to know the new matrimonial family, work around issues if any and bless the family she is married into by acting like Goddess she is expected to be as per Indian traditions. This has to stop if we want to protect the beautiful institution called Marriage.
 - c. If the wife has not conspired to break the husband's relations with his side's family and the house has progressed, then a law will be made making it mandatory to give the wife half of the wealth that increased after marriage, at the time of divorce.

- i. If, after marriage, the house of the husband who was living with his parents has suffered damage, then a law will be made to recover half of the loss from the wife's family.

(3) During ongoing domestic disputes, the children will stay with the mother for fifteen days and with the father for the remaining days of the month. Any parent who creates obstacles or gives excuses to prevent this will have their rights over the children completely removed, and no financial benefit will be allowed to such a person. **This law will ensure that the future of the victim and the children remains the government's top priority.**

We reiterate, a new law containing all these provisions will be enacted. Some steps were taken in this regard in 2013, but no further action was taken. Therefore, this law will be made within the first two weeks.

Page 452 -

There is the 217th Report of the Law Commission which also recommended that irretrievable breakdown should be a ground for divorce, an additional ground for divorce. Of course, this particular amendment only deals with irretrievable breakdown of marriage. It doesn't deal with other provisions of the Hindu Marriage Act. The recommendations of the Law Commission and the recommendations of the Supreme Court were in the context of the Hindu Marriage Act. And it is in that context that we have brought this provision and, of course, also in the context of the Special Marriage Act. The two amendments that we are talking about are amendments to the Hindu Marriage Act and amendments to the Special Marriage Act. In other words, people of any religion, if they so choose, can actually get their marriage registered under the Special Marriage Act. The provisions that Najmaji was talking about will apply to them. But we must give that choice to citizens of our country. We can't foist laws. For example, even in this legislation, it protects Hindu custom and usage. There are several customs and usages around the country with respect to marriages which are also protected under the Hindu Marriage Act and even under this piece of legislation. So, if Hindu custom and usage is to be protected, then other customs and usages must also be protected.

Page 458 -

Women are 50 per cent of the population of the world, but they own two per cent of the assets of the world. That's the reality of global civilisation. Ninety-eight per cent of the assets of the world are held by 50 per cent of the population of this world and they are all males.

Now, a distinguished Member of this House asked: How can we trust a Judge because the **latest Transparency Report says that 36 per cent of Judges are corrupt? How do we trust politicians with laws because the latest survey says that lots of politicians are corrupt? But, we still have to pass laws and we still have to trust our Judges.** We trust and hope that this situation will improve and I hope we will bring forward a legislation to that effect in this country so that what happens in the judiciary improves and what happens here also improves. So, I don't think that that can be a premise on which you can decide as to what kind of laws should be passed. The Judge will decide in the facts and circumstances of each case as to how the property should be distributed.

Page 459 –

These are three amendments in the Hindu Marriage Act and three amendments in the Special Marriage Act. The other is only changing the year of the Act and things like that. The other major amendment is that we have seen, in the past, and this has been our experience, couples go to court by mutual consent, and this has to be done after six months of marriage and before 18 months they have to come back to court, and it is only then that the court grants a divorce by mutual consent. We see many a time though the first application is made, the second application is never made because one of the parties backs out. So, that leads to a prolonged litigation even though the marriage is broken down. So, what we have said is that if after six months when the first application is made, three years passed, one of the parties actually do not cooperate, then, the other party can go to court and say that three years have passed, please give me a divorce by mutual consent.



27) Reservation Policy

- (a) **An online transparent system** will disclose all reservation-related data. Creamy-layer and one-time-use rules will apply across categories, limiting benefits to two generations per family. Population-proportional quotas, Kunbi-Maratha certificates, and Dhargar ST status will ensure genuine equity. Opposition by individuals/organisations/groups to these fair reforms will attract twenty-year hard-labour sentences.
- (b) A new reservation framework aligned with constitutional equality will be announced within six months.

Detailed thoughts for these reforms –

To promote impartial opportunities and social justice, the party's government is committed to encouraging **a balanced and transparent reservation policy**. This will ensure that the benefits reach the most

deserving individuals, prevent misuse, and promote fairness among all communities.

Due to the above first twenty-one laws/changes, nearly fifty lakh crore rupees will become available every year for the welfare of the people. Law and order will become impregnable, all problems in the areas of roads, garbage, education, and health will be completely resolved, corruption will be brought under control by 50% to 80%, and there will be such prosperity in the country that the entire country will be happy.

Through all this, the people will develop unshakeable faith in the intentions of the government. Therefore, the sensitive issue of reservation will be happily resolved immediately with the help of the support of all happy communities.

a) For quality decision-making, our party government will create an online system that provides every common citizen with complete information regarding the education, admission, and employment of every person working in any government system. Our government will enact a law in the first month stating that no crime will be registered if such information is sought.

b) Inclusive Reservation Framework:

The party will support the issuance of Kunbi-Maratha certificates, include the Dhangar community in the Scheduled Tribes (ST) category, and support reservation in proportion to population. This will provide educational and employment opportunities to historically neglected groups.

c) Division of Reserved and Open Categories:

To promote fair entry, a policy will be implemented whereby candidates from the reserved category will not be allowed to compete in the open category for government recruitment and educational admissions. This will secure opportunities for both reserved and general categories and increase fairness. Even Supreme Court will not be allowed to change this provision of Law.

d) Creamy Layer and One-Time Benefit Rule:

To ensure that reservation benefits reach the most deprived and to prevent monopoly by a handful of individuals from certain categories, **the party government, upon coming to power, will implement the creamy layer and classification criteria for all reservation categories**, similar to the current central government rules for Other Backward Classes (OBC) (e.g., ₹8 lakh annual income).

In addition, reservation benefits will be limited as follows:

i) One-Time Use:

Every individual will be able to avail reservation benefits only certain times in their lifetime (e.g., only once up to degree education and twice for securing employment). This will ensure wide distribution of opportunities.

ii) Parent-Child Restriction:

Only one parent-child pair across two generations in a family will be allowed to avail reservation benefits. This policy will prevent multi-generational dependency.

It aligns with the principle of fixed tenure set for elected representatives, increases fairness, and curbs permanent privileges in reserved categories.

Our party's government will create an inclusive, fair, and transparent reservation system in the first six months that is aligned with the constitutional objectives of social justice. This will provide opportunities to those in need and, within a short time, promote a merit-based and unified society.

If any disruptive elements oppose this, a law will be enacted in the first month imposing a direct sentence of twenty years of rigorous imprisonment on them. The new reservation system will be announced within the next six months.

28) Protection from Moneylenders :-

The government will operate a mortgage scheme allowing citizens to pledge land/flat at half the project-acquisition rate. Land will be returned upon repayment, permanently shielding families from exploitative private usury/private lenders.

29) Social Harmony Project for a Prosperous Society

Public office and social service will be promoted as duties not as something for personal profit.

Citizens will be encouraged to choose one of six life roles for ten years & not get greedy and claim all for oneself/one's family —

1. government job
2. private employment,
3. small business,
4. large enterprise,
5. investment, or
6. selfless service — rejecting endless greed-driven life. The guiding principle will be “one person, one role,” fostering a satisfied, spiritually enriched nation.

30) Promotion of Arts and Cultural Heritage

Quarterly cultural festivals will celebrate local traditions and empower indigenous artists, providing advancement opportunities that enrich national heritage and community pride.

31) Swift Justice and Zero-Tolerance Anti-Corruption Measures :-

- (a) Dedicated wartime-speed teams will deliver instant justice on legitimate demands, preventing loss of life from prolonged protests for just causes like Farmer's agitations, Hindutva-protector Maratha reservation Agitation. Ignoring these just demands caused many to lose life, BJP-Free Marathwada took place due to these in Lok Sabha 2024 elections. Loss of agitator's life is nothing to be proud of hence every demand will be assigned a dedicated team to reach a conclusion, with use of Grok AI type tools and lives will be protected by swift decision making.

- A. Public Accountability System: If credible evidence of corruption is found against any officer, his family members will have to temporarily bear public marking, such as displaying “Mera Rishtedar Shayad Chor Hain...” on their forehead, on social media, or in public records.
- B. If the charges are proved, the marking will be “Mera Rishtedar Chor Hain...”, made on foreheads of family of accused, which will be permanent and preventive.
- C. If the charges are not proved, all markings will be removed, thereby ensuring fairness. But no one will dare to commit corruption out of fear..!!

iii. Equal Treatment and Legal Reforms:

The party will treat all citizens as one family and will ensure that no injustice in the true sense of democracy remains in the country.

iv. Reforms in Divisive Laws:

Historical laws such as the Hindu Code Bills implemented in 1955 under the leadership of Pandit Nehru have been criticised for creating discord in Hindu families due to unequal provisions on property and inheritance. Article VII: Amendments

This decision was formalized through amendments to the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, notified in March/April 2022. Specifically:

- Regulation 17(1B) of the LODR Regulations, which would have enforced the separation (with the Chairperson required to be a non-executive director and not related to the MD/CEO as defined under the Companies Act, 2013), was omitted.
- Listed entities are now permitted, but not required, to appoint separate persons for the roles of Chairperson and MD/CEO, with the Chairperson being a non-executive director and unrelated to the MD/CEO.

No subsequent amendments or reversals to this voluntary status appear in regulatory updates through 2025 or early 2026. Recent SEBI notifications and amendments to the LODR Regulations (including those in 2025 and 2026) have focused on other areas, such as related party transactions, high-value debt listed entities (HVDLE) governance, dematerialization processes, and ease of doing business, **without reinstating or altering the mandatory nature of the Chairperson-MD/CEO separation.**

In summary, the "deadline" is effectively defunct as a compulsory requirement; the rule remains in place only on a voluntary basis for listed companies.

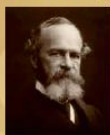
